

CeeD Awards 2022 – COVID Safety Considerations

As we prepare for the CeeD Industry Awards 2022, we wanted to bring the current Scottish Government COVID-19 guidelines to your attention.

While the majority of restrictions have now eased, we have been working with the Glasgow Hilton to ensure that we create a safe environment for our attendees, and we will of course be following the Scottish Government rules and restrictions that will be in place at the time of the awards.

We are expecting over 500 guests at the awards ceremony on 24th February 2022. According to current guidelines, this means that guests will be required to show their proof of two vaccinations status or a negative lateral flow result (from NHS website) at the hotel entry, unless exempt.

Proof of Vaccination Status - www.covidcheck.scot

The easiest way is to use the NHS Scotland Covid Status app, which keeps vaccine status updated, and is the easiest way to ensure the records and QR codes are up to date.

Alternatively, you can request a paper copy of your vaccine status or download a pdf copy.

Downloading the app takes minutes – please see the attached guidelines if you do not have the app installed on your mobile already.

Negative Lateral Flow - <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result>

If you are unable to prove your vaccination status, you will need to take a lateral flow test on the day of the event – and preferably within 2-3 hours of the start time. If this is negative, please register the result via the gov.uk website (see link above) and either download or print off a copy of the confirmation email you will receive as a result of logging your test online.
